



# TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2023-2024

## Applying to the CState2NKU Program

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at Cincinnati State, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at Cincinnati State.

## Degree Requirements for Cincinnati State

1) Completion of minimum 62 credit hours, 36 of which from approved Transfer courses, 2) minimum cumulative GPA 2.0, 3) completion of an FYE course as part of the first 12 credit hours taken at Cincinnati State, and 4) completion of Cooperative Education

## Admission Requirements for NKU

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

Students wishing to enroll in the elementary education program must follow the admission guidelines for teacher education programs outlined by the College of Education. (Courses in parentheses are Cincinnati State course equivalents)

- x A minimum overall GPA of 2.75
- x A minimum grade of "B" in CMST 101 (COMM 110) and ENG 102 (ENG 102/103)
- x A minimum grade of "C" in all other pre-admission courses and required EDU and EDS courses, which include EDU 300 (EDU 210), EDU 305 (EDU 105), EDU 310 (EDU

EDU 316, and EDS 360 (EDU 200).
